# **Legislative Updates**

### **County Housing Task Force Declares Homelessness a Crisis**

In early October, the Santa Clara County Housing Task Force unanimously passed a <u>resolution</u> declaring the problem of homelessness to be a crisis, and calling on cities within the County to pursue several specific strategies to fund affordable housing. The resolution was drafted by Councilmember Rocha, who was appointed by Mayor Liccardo to represent the City of San Jose on the Task Force.

### **Grant for Rehabilitation of Vermont House to House Homeless Veterans**

The Council voted on November 10, 2015 to renovate a dilapidated apartment building on Vermont Street. This building will house 16 homelessness veterans.

# **Increase of Fines Related to Illegal Dumping**

Challenges of illegal dumping have increased significantly in our neighborhoods; 50% increase in incidences and 75% in amount of illegal dumping in the last 3 years. The Council voted on November 10, 2015 to amend City ordinance regarding illegal dumping and related citations. Staff was directed to build an interactive reporting tool on the City of San Jose website, and develop an educational campaign to inform residents about the need to reduce illegal dumping. Resolution N. 77570 was adopted, amending the Administrative Citation Schedule of Fines to add new fines for illegal dumping.

### **Priority Setting**

Under the process, City Council Priority Setting sessions are held twice yearly. The next session is scheduled to take place December 8<sup>th</sup>. The last chance for Council memos to be heard at Rules for consideration at the City Council Priority Setting Session was today, November 18<sup>th</sup>.
