3.1. Executive Director (Morrisey)

Accept Reports on Arena Authority Oversight

SAP Center at San Jose. Executive Director Morrisey sent a letter to the California High-Speed Rail Authority regarding their Draft 2018 Business Plan (see agenda item 3.1.a.) During recent Stanley Cup Playoffs, police vehicles and dump trucks were used to close off Autumn Street. The planter boxes along W. Santa Clara Street and Autumn Street have been put in place. The Department of Transportation will be replacing four older changeable message signs around the Center with new dynamic message signs. The 2019 NHL All-Star Game will be held at the Center. The Board for the Bay Area Rapid Transit - following recommendations from the City and the Valley Transportation Authority - has approved to bore a single, underground rail alignment for the portion of the BART subway through Downtown San Jose.

- <u>Solar4America Ice at San Jose (Verbal)</u>. Heavy construction is underway to replace the two original ice rinks at the facility. The project is anticipated to be completed in August. Preliminary plans have been submitted by Sharks Sports & Entertainment to the City to expand the ice facility by adding two new rinks, locker rooms, a ticket lobby and lounge.
- <u>San Jose Municipal Stadium (Verbal)</u>. Minor repair work was recently done on the stadium exterior gates. For the upcoming fiscal year, the City's Department of Public Works has submitted a budget request to completely replace the fence and gates near the stadium ticket windows. Work is scheduled to replace the press box windows.
