Re: San Jose Campaign Guidance

Dear Andrew:


You have asked the following question: Whether left over funds from the Primary Election may be carried over to the General Election?

The City Council has revised the Sections in the San José Municipal Code to clarify the use of leftover funds from a City Primary Election and the use of remaining campaign funds to a General Election. Effective December 18, 2015, under San Jose Municipal Code Section 12.06.420 (C), a candidate who becomes eligible to run in a General Election may transfer and use any remaining funds from the Primary Election in the General Election.
