NEW BUSINESS

A. Discussion of Draft Report

Deputy City Clerk Anh Tran provided a draft report. Commission started dicussion with the following changes:

- 1. For the Mayor, increase the authorized salary as recommended by the Commission for FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17 from \$114,000 annually to \$125,000 annually.
- 2. For each Councilmember, increase the authorized salary as recommended by the Commission for FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17 from \$81,000 annually to \$92,000 annually.
- 3. Retain the levels of health, dental, life insurance and other benefits through FY 2016 2017 in accordance with the benefits provided to management employees in Unit 99 and salary continuation insurance benefits.
- 4. Increase the vehicle allowance from \$350 to \$500 per month for the Mayor and each member of the City Council.
- 5. Continue to require Councilmembers to pay \$250 for each unexcused absence at scheduled Council meetings, pursuant to City Charter Section 407.
- 6. Increase the stipend for Board of Administration and the Police and Fire Department Retirement Plan Board of Administration from \$150 to \$225 per board meeting for any non-City employee member.
