1. Call to Order

2. <u>Chairperson Report</u>

Chair Cord commented on a request for additional written reports to the DPB on various topics including the Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) with projected start and end dates for projects and an update on the Smart Meter Program.

3. <u>Annual Work Plan</u>

The board reviewed the FY 2017-18 Annual Work Plan, with Arian Collen (DOT) noting the need for several edits to the Work Plan to be brought to the Board at the October 4, 2017 meeting for final approval. Additional edits and items to include a newly formatted Work Plan, the addition of an Annual Report, and a supporting Memo to the City's Transportation and Environment council Committee as required by City policy. A discussion ensued with the board requesting an additional edit to include a report on the status of Smart Meters at the October 2017 meeting and a Parking Program Strategy discussion at the February 2018 meeting.

Mr. Collen presented a handout outlining the May 2017 average peak occupancy for daytime and evening periods at the Market Street, Third Street, 4th/San Fernando, and 2nd/San Carlos Garages. The handout also included a summary analysis outlining projected parking demand and occupancy based on existing contractual agreements. A discussion ensued on the following items:

- Occupancy on Wednesday at 4th/San Fernando and commitments to Rotary and availability to offer SJSU permits
- Various parking agreements, including the 50 W. San Fernando commitment
