A. Presentation: Police Annual Report; Aaron Zisser, Independent Police Auditor.

Mr. Zisser presented on his office's processes and the findings of his FY2016-17 Annual Report with a focus on the gender breakdown of complaints against the San Jose Police Department as well as findings related to domestic violence work.

- B) Create or allow the Human Services Commission to create a three-year taskforce including both members of the public and members of the Human Services Commission.
- **C.** Commissioner resource deployment to support the Rapid Response Network; Commissioner Dickinson-Goodman

D. Work Plan Progress reports; Commissioners Maciel, Barocio, Estrada, Dotson, and Lopez

The Commissioners asked the Commissioners Maciel and Barocio were removed from future progress reports as their work is concluded for this fiscal year and add Commissioner Ly.

Commissioner Dotson reported that he has connected with a local group in Willow Glen around creating a human trafficking initiative and will continue to move forward with that work.

Commissioner Ly reported that the Children's Rights Showcase was ready to go with 5-7 performances, art projects from children, a resource fair, and even fashion design work. She also listed a number of giveaways that she had gotten donated for the event.
