Shall an ordinance be adopted amending the San José
Municipal Code to include Medical Marijuana Collectives as
an allowed land use in agricultural, commercial pedestrian,
commercial neighborhood, industrial park, light industrial,
heavy industrial zoning districts, and certain planned
development zoning districts, and to establish a registration
process and zoning code verification certificate process?

The nomination period for these offices begins on February 15, 2016 and closes on March 11, 2016 at 12:00 p.m. (Noon). Due to the President's Day Holiday, City Hall will be closed on February 15; therefore, nomination papers may be picked up on Tuesday, February 16, 2016.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the city are not filed by March 11, 2016 (the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election), the voters shall have until the 83<sup>rd</sup> day before the election, noon, March 16, 2016 to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election, for that incumbent's elective office. This extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by § 10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
