4. Reducing the Cost of Home Improvements

Direct the City Manager or her designee(s) to examine ways the PBCE may reduce the costs of single-family home renovation and improvement projects by means including but not limited to reducing the overhead rates on small projects or creating a second-tier fee/tax schedule that excludes amortization of costs unrelated to small improvement projects such as traffic impacts. Return to Community and Economic Development Committee with recommendations for implementation of cost-saving measures. (Khamis)
