4. Paid Parental Leave

Direct staff to explore the budget and policy considerations of providing full-time City of San Jose employees with one calendar month of paid parental leave before, during and after the birth or adoption of a child and return to Council prior to February 2014. (Nguyen/Rocha)

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Vice Mayor Madison Nguyen and Councilmember Donald Rocha dated August 14, 2013, to the Rules and Open Government Committee forwarding the recommendations.

<u>Discussion</u>: The Committee had a lengthy discussion on policies already in place, potential budget impacts, and paid leave for major life events. Deputy City Manager Alex Gurza noted that staff would review major life events as a separate item, and will provide an Informational Memorandum to the Committee prior to February 2014.

<u>Public Comments</u>: Martha O'Connell stated the Item needs further discussion. Adele Cruz representing 4 C's of Santa Clara County spoke in support of Item G.4. David Wall offered suggestions to restore City employee's lost wages.

<u>Action</u>: The Committee referred Item G.4 to staff for further analysis and to include in their analysis paid leave for major life events, and to return prior to February 2014.

- 5. AB 443 (Lowenthal) Vehicles: Delinquent Parking and Traffic Violations. (Transportation) (a) Pursuant to the City's streamlined bill process for responding quickly to legislative proposals, re-affirm a position of support regarding AB 443 (Lowenthal).
 - (b) Recommend a one-week turnaround to the City Council so that the City's legislative representative can continue to advocate the City's support for AB 443.

<u>Documents Filed</u>: AB 443 (Lowenthal) - from Hans F. Larsen, Director of Transportation to the Rules and Open Government Committee dated August 15, 2013, forwarding the recommendations.

Director of Intergovernmental Relations Betsy Shotwell noted AB 443 was recently signed into law by the Governor. Department of Transportation Assistant Director James Ortbal provided further explanation and answered the Committee's questions.

<u>Public Comment</u>: David Wall suggested that Item G.5 should be amended to include tougher fines.
