- 5. North San Jose Traffic Impact Incentive Program (Mayor)
 Agendize for the September 24, 2013, City Council meeting to approve an amendment to the
 North San José Traffic Impact Fee Incentive Program to:
 - a. Increase the total square footage available for the incentive program to 4 million square fee;
 - b. Reduce the Traffic Impact Fee to \$2.00/sf for any build-to-suit Office/R&D campus of over 1 million square feet that obtains planning and building approvals by December 31, 2014; and
 - c. Direct the City Manager to return in the FY 2014-15 budget process, with the total amount of tax revenues generated by the qualifying projects from sources such as the Building and Structures fee, Utility tax, or Business Cooperation Program, and with recommendations for amounts of those tax revenues that could be transferred to the North San José transportation fund.
