Upon motion by Board Member Shannon, seconded by Board Member Williams and carried unanimously, the agenda was adopted. (6-0-1. Absent: Estremera.)

6. Items Scheduled for Action/Discussion

6.1 Third Amendment to the Off-Site Improvement & Disbursement Agreement – North San Pedro Housing.

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Successor Agency Managing Director, Richard Keit, dated December 8, 2017, recommending adoption of a resolution.

Successor Agency Managing Director, Richard Keit offered an overview. Senior Deputy City Attorney Tom Murtha explained that the draft agreement provided to the Department of Finance includes additional language that the Grant Funds shall be the sole source of funding to satisfy the Successor Agency's obligation under the Disposition and Development Agreements (DDA's) to provide Affordable Housing Assistance to First Community Housing ("FCH") and the use of such Grant Funds by FCH shall satisfy the Successor Agency's remaining obligation under the DDAs to provide Affordable Housing Assistance to FCH. The Agency is awaiting a response from the Department of Finance before the final agreement can be reposted.

Motion: Board Member Andrade moved approval of the Agreement, including the language as noted by staff. Board Member Shannon seconded the motion.

Action: On a call for the question, the motion carried unanimously, <u>Oversight Board Resolution No. 2017-12-1160</u>, entitled "A Resolution of the Oversight Board of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San José: (A) Approving a Third Amendment to the Amended and Restated Off-Site Improvement and Disbursement Agreement Among the Successor Agency, North San Pedro Townhomes LLC, San Pedro Life 1 LLC, and First Community Housing (FCH) to Require FCH to

Use \$949,541.26 of State Prop 1C, Infill and Infrastructure Grant Funds Towards Construction of the Affordable Housing Project; and (B) Finding that the Third Amendment to the Amended and Restated Off-Site Improvement and Disbursement Agreement Will Increase Revenues, Decrease Liabilities, and is in the Best Interest of the Taxing Entities", was adopted. (6-0-1. Absent: Estremera.)

Successor Agency Chief Financial Officer Julia Cooper offered a brief presentation on the Independent Auditor's Report.

<u>Action</u>: Upon motion by Board Member Shannon, seconded by Board Member Andrade and carried unanimously, the Independent Auditor's Report and Basic Financial Statements for the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2017 was accepted. (6-0-1. Absent: Estremera.)

6.3 Presentation on Status of Successor Agency Property Dispositions

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Successor Agency Managing Director Richard A. Keit, dated December 8, 2017 regarding Status of Successor Agency Property Dispositions.

Successor Agency Managing Director, Richard Keit provided an update on property sales and the proposed disposition of assets and responded to questions from the Board.

Chair Estremera arrived at 10:23 a.m. and chaired the remainder of the meeting.

Board Member Williams asked that staff research balances on each of the collateralized properties, explore pre-payment penalties, and move forward in particular with the sale of the South Hall and 62 South Second properties, providing a report at the next meeting of the Board.

<u>Public Comment</u>: Jenny Treis, Program Manager with the County of Santa Clara, indicated her expectation that an appraisal of the Market Gateway housing property will be done by the end of this month.

Action: The report was accepted, with staff to return with additional information as requested by the Board.
