6.1 Approval of the Transfer of a Governmental Purpose Property

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Successor Agency Managing Director Richard A. Keit, dated September 8, 2017 entitled Transfer of Governmental Purpose Property – Almaden Avenue.

Senior Deputy City Attorney Tom Murtha provided a presentation. Board Member Cauble asked that the wording in the resolution regarding having no negotiation agreement be reworded. Senior Deputy City Attorney Tom Murtha agreed to clarify the language in the resolution to indicate that there were no agreements relating to the original construction or use of the asset as a public right of way.

<u>Action</u>: Upon motion by Board Member Cauble, seconded by Board Member Andrade and carried unanimously, <u>Oversight Board Resolution No. 2017-09-1156</u>, entitled "A Resolution of the Oversight Board of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San José Approving the Transfer of a Portion of Almaden Avenue, Between West San Carlos Street and Park Avenue, as a Governmental Purpose Property, from the Successor Agency to the City of San José in Accordance With Health and Safety Code Section 34181(A)", was adopted. 6.2 Third Amendment to the Off-Site Improvement & Disbursement Agreement -North San Pedro Housing

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Successor Agency Managing Director Richard A. Keit, dated September 8, 2017 entitled Third Amendment to the Off-Site Improvement & Disbursement Agreement -North San Pedro Housing.

Successor Agency Managing Director, Richard Keit offered a presentation and responded to questions.

Action: Upon motion by Board Member Shannon, seconded by Board Member Williams and carried unanimously, Oversight Board Resolution No. 2017-09-1157, entitled: "A Resolution of the Oversight Board to the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San José: (a) Approving a Third Amendment to the Amended and Restated Off-Site Improvement and Disbursement Agreement Among the Successor Agency, North San Pedro Townhomes LLC, San Pedro Life 1 LLC, and First Community Housing; and (b) Finding that the Third Amendment to the Amended and Restated Off-Site Improvement and Disbursement Agreement Will Increase Revenues, Decrease Liabilities, and is in the Best Interest of the Taxing Entities", was adopted. Akatiff Revocable Trust (Buyer) in an amount not-to-exceed of \$33,500 for the purchase by Buyer of approximately 670 square feet of property adjacent to Old Julian Street between North Autumn Street and Autumn Parkway; and
- (2) Authorizing the Managing Director or his designee to execute the sale agreement and all other documents necessary to complete the transaction.
