6.1 Approval of Sale of Real Property Located at 501 Vine Street and Offers Received for Real Property at 551 West Julian Street.

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Successor Agency Managing Director Richard A. Keit, dated November 4, 2016, recommending adoption of resolutions.

Successor Agency Managing Director Richard A. Keit provided a brief overview.

Item 6.1(a) 501 Vine Street:

Action: Upon motion by Board Member Guthrie, seconded by Board Member Cauble and carried unanimously, <u>Resolution No. 2016-11-1129</u>, entitled: "A Resolution of the Oversight Board of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San José Approving the Sale of Real Property Located at 501 Vine Street Owned by the Successor Agency to the Highest Bidder, J3 Inc., a California Corporation, for a Purchase Price of \$876,000", was adopted. (7-0.)

Item 6.1(b) 551 West Julian Street:

<u>Public Comment</u>: Dennis Randall, representing Insight Realty, noted that his company was the highest bidder and had bid the fair price given circumstances of the sale and considering significant groundwater contamination.

Action: Upon motion by Board Member Guthrie, seconded by Vice-Chair Maduli and carried unanimously, <u>Resolution No. 2016-11-1130</u>, entitled: "A Resolution of the Oversight Board of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San José Rejecting all Three Bids Received for the Sale of the Real Property Located at 551 West Julian Street and Authorizing the Successor Agency Staff to Re-Solicit the Property Within the Next Three Months", was adopted. (7-0.)

## 6.2 Disposition Process Discussion and Action and Amend the Asset Disposition Schedule.

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Successor to the Redevelopment Agency Chief Financial Officer, Julia H. Cooper, dated November 4, 2016, recommending adoption of a resolution.

Assistant Director of Finance, Derek Hansel, provided background comments, and discussion followed.

Action: Upon motion by Board Member Guthrie, seconded by Vice Chair Maduli, and carried unanimously, Resolution No. 2016-11-1131, entitled: "A Resolution of the Oversight Board of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San José Authorizing the Successor Agency to Select a Bond Underwriting Team to Assist in the Development and Implementation of Other Financial Obligations Incurred by the Former Redevelopment Agency, the Costs of which will be Paid Solely from a Sale of Refunding Bonds", was adopted. (7-0.)

# 6.3 Status Report on the Successor Agency's Active Disposition and Development Agreements and Active Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions Affecting Real Property.

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Successor Agency Managing Director Richard A. Keit, dated November 4, 2016, providing a status report in response to the Board's request for a list of open Disposition and Development Agreements (DDA's).

Successor Agency Managing Director Richard A. Keit offered background information, provided the status report and indicated there was no action required on this item.

Successor Agency Managing Director Richard A. Keit and Senior Deputy City Attorney Tom Murtha responded to questions from the Board.

Board Member Debbie Cauble recommended that staff return with summary report on the nature of the obligations in February 2017.
