6.3 <u>Second Amendment to the Off-Site Improvement & Disbursement Agreement North San</u> Pedro

Adopt a resolution:

Approving a Second Amendment to the Amended and Restated Off-Site Improvement and Disbursement Agreement ("Improvement Agreement") among the Successor Agency, North San Pedro Townhomes LLC, San Pedro Life 1 LLC, and First Community Housing ("FCH"), the Affordable Housing Developer for the Project, to amend the Agreement to (a) delete FCH's right to use up to One Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,600,000) of Grant Funds for the Affordable Housing Project, (b) allow the Successor Agency or another party to the Improvement Agreement to use up to, or a portion of, the One Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,600,000) of Grant Funds to reimburse itself for costs previously incurred in connection with the development and construction of the Project as defined in the Disposition and Development Agreements ("DDA"), and (c) provide that, upon receipt of such funds, the party receiving such Grant Funds shall disburse such funds to FCH to satisfy the remainder of the Successor Agency obligation to provide Affordable Housing Assistance to FCH as defined in the DDAs.
