


- San José will have an interconnected, 100-mile trail network by 2022.

- Develop lower maintenance projects


The bike web - 500 miles of bike facilities by 2022

- ► Already within 3 miles of all residents





- ▶ 1500 daily users (Los Gatos Creek Trail)




- ► Opportunity (grant funds SCVWD and CA)

Bridge Location






Core elements


- Viewing area

- ► Low maintenance (bridge and channel)










BRIDGE REPLACEMENT SAN JOSE CA. JULY 1/13




