Rebuttal to argument against Measure F

Measure F enables *the San Jose Police Department to attract more officers to patrol our neighborhoods, investigate violent crimes, and respond to 911 calls.* "Police staffing is at a crisis level. We need Measure F to replace the 500 officers San Jose has lost since 2008", says Police Chief Eddie Garcia.

Measure F safeguards disability protections for police officers and firefighters injured in the line of duty. It reflects a consensus agreement supported by a diverse coalition of community leaders and city employees focused on making *San José safer and more financially sustainable*.
