SUPER BOWL 50 DOWNTOWN SPECIAL EVENT ZONE PROHIBITION ORDINANCE

Effective 6:00 a.m. Monday, February 1, 2016 through 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, February 9, 2016

- The sale of any item, including food and merchandise, by mobile peddlers or by placing other physical objects in any public area is prohibited within the Downtown Special Event
- The sale or distribution of any counterfeit or illegal merchandise, free merchandise, free samples and coupons
- Do not sell or distribute any products within the Downtown Special Event Zone from February 1 through February 9.
- Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and subject to a \$1,000 administrative fine and/or confiscation of
- The use of Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) commonly known as "drones" is prohibited from being deployed. launched or flown in any airspace within or over the Special
