This is an invitation to attend a community meeting to discuss a rezoning, three development permits, two tentative maps, and a parkland agreement that are under review by the City of San Jose. Planning staff will facilitate this meeting, providing you an opportunity to learn about the proposals and get answers to your questions. We are very interested in your input on this project and encourage your attendance at this meeting. We will consider all comments during our evaluation of the proposal.

<u>Planned Development Rezoning File No. PDC16-001.</u> Conforming Planned Development Rezoning to redistribute the locations of the residential and public park land uses and eliminate the school land use on the northern portion of the approved Land Use Map (File No. PDC09-006).

<u>Planned Development Permit and Tentative Map File Nos. PD16-002/PT15-067.</u> Planned Development Permit to subdivide and allow up to 168 single family attached residential units and a 3.6 acre park.

Planned Development Permit and Tentative Map File Nos. PDA12-031-01/PT15-068. A Planned Development Permit Amendment to the approved, but not constructed multi-family housing development to increase the number of units from 495 to 545 units and add approximately 37,000 square feet of commercial space and associate changes to the architecture for Blocks 9, 10 and 11.

Parkland Agreement. The Department of Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services invites community members to share ideas and inspire the design of two approximately 3.6 acre public parks, that will be constructed alongside the above projects to serve new and surrounding neighborhoods.






