

DAMAGE SURVEY REQUEST FORM

For properties damaged by flooding, fire, vehicles, or other catastrophes, the property owner or authorized contractor may receive expedited plan review and inspections by arranging for a City Inspector to conduct a Damage Survey. This is optional but benefits you as inspections and plan review will be given scheduling priority.

The City Inspector will create a report that outlines the required permits for repairing the damaged property and, if needed, inform you of the steps to reconnect utility meters. The City Inspector will leave a copy of the Damage Survey Report at the property site. The report can also be found at <u>SJPermits.org</u> by the next business day afternoon following the inspection. It will post to the property's address information.

If your property is nonresidential, please also read <u>Bulletin 292-Utility Meters: How to Get or Replace a Meter</u>.

HOW TO ARRANGE FOR A DAMAGE SURVEY

- 1. Go to <u>SJPermits.org</u>, set up an account, and apply for the Damage Survey online. For help, see SJPermits <u>User Guides</u>. Pay the fee online by eCheck or credit card and download the permit/survey information.
- 2. IMPORTANT: To schedule a City Inspector to perform the Damage Survey, call 408-535-3555 and you will be given priority scheduling. Do not use the online inspection scheduling feature of SJPermits.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE COMPUTER ACCESS - Using <u>SJPermits</u> is the fastest way to file a Damage Survey Request. If that's not possible, follow these steps:

- 1. Complete this form and bring it to the Permit Center, or mail it with a payment check to:
 - San José City Hall Permit Center, 1st Floor 200 E. Santa Clara Street San José, CA 95113
- 2. City staff will provide you with an IR Folder Number that authorizes you to request a survey inspection.
- 3. Call 408-535-3555 to schedule the inspection. Be ready to provide the IR Folder Number and property address.

FEES

Filing online at SJPermits: \$402 (includes \$315 inspection fee, \$56 processing fee, and \$31 record retention fee)

Filing at Permit Center or by mail: \$459 (includes \$315 inspection fee, \$113 processing fee, and \$31 record retention fee). The higher fee is due to increased staff time. For methods of payment, see www.sanjoseca.gov/BuildingFees.
