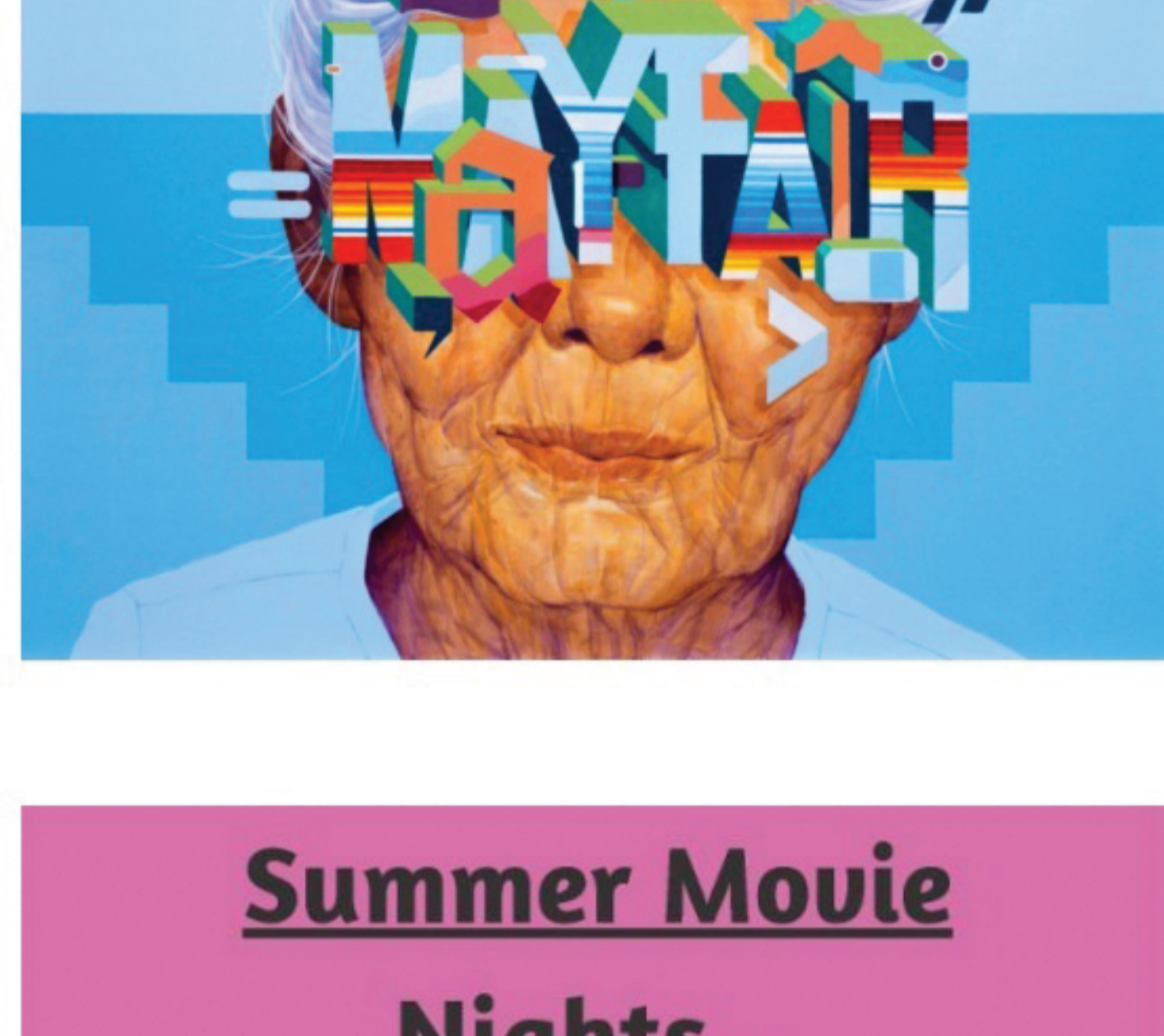

- Right to vote for president and in local and state elections.
- Sponsor family members to immigrate to the United States more quickly than those sponsored by LPR family members.
- Children under 18 years old may automatically qualify for citizenship.
- Travel and visit family abroad without worrying about losing your legal status.
- No fear of deportation or having to renew your green card.

The National Immigration Forum's **New American Workforce** is offering a free info session on citizenship. Immigration specialists will help you figure out if you are eligible and answer your questions on how to apply.
