## Operating Engineers, Local 3 – Shift Differential 5.3

## Proposal # 6

- 5.3 Shift Differential. Eligible employees, as defined herein, regularly assigned to work a swing shift, shall be paid a shift differential of \$1.55 \$2.00 per hour for each eligible hour, as defined herein, to the nearest fifteen (15) minutes, of work performed. Eligible employees, as defined herein, regularly assigned to work a graveyard shift shall be paid a shift differential of \$1.75 \$2.35 per hour, as defined herein, to the nearest fifteen (15) minutes of work performed.
- -5.3.1 Eligibility and Application. To be eligible for payment of shift differential, an employee must be assigned to an on-going, regular shift of eight (8) hours or more.—which is regularly scheduled to start between the hours of:
- a) 2:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. (i.e. swing shift), or
- b) 12:00 midnight and 5:59 a.m. (i.e. graveyard shift)
- 5.3.2 A swing shift is <u>defined as any</u> regular shift of eight (8) hours or more <del>regularly scheduled to start</del> when work is performed <u>by an employee</u> between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and <del>119</del>:59 p.m.
- 5.3.3 A graveyard shift is <u>defined as</u> any regular shift of eight (8) hours or more <del>regularly scheduled to start</del> when work is performed by an employee between the hours of <del>12 Midnight</del> 10:00 pm and 5:59 a.m. <u>Any employee who performs work during the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:59 a.m. will be considered to have worked the graveyard shift.</u>

If the employee's-shift starts within the time period defined above and the employee works a minimum of two (2) hours within that time period, t-The employee shall be compensated with the applicable shift differential for the entire shift.

5.3.2 4 Except as otherwise required by applicable State or Federal law, shift differential pay shall not be included as regular compensation in computing other benefits.
