We believe that meeting in person and participating in a meaningful discussion regarding your latest proposal is the most effective use of the time we have left prior to the completion of the negotiation process on October 31, 2011, and the City's negotiation team will be prepared to do so. Please confirm that you, or your designated representative, will be in attendance and prepared to answer questions and engage in a substantive dialogue regarding your proposal of September 28, 2011, at our next negotiation session on October 5, 2011.
