On July 29, 2011, we had a retirement reform negotiation session in which representatives from ABMEI, CEO, IBEW, MEF and OE#3 were in attendance. In addition, AFSCME invited a representative from its organization. During this meeting, the Unions provided a 2nd Tier Retirement proposal to the City.
