RE: City/ALP Negotiations

Dear Ms. Todorov:

We are in receipt of your email dated October 27, 2011, in which you confirm our conversation regarding the negotiation session that was scheduled for 1:30 p.m. on October 27th. You indicated that you were not prepared to discuss the revised draft proposed ballot measure that you received earlier on the morning of October 27th. In your email you propose that we meet on November 2nd or 3rd.

As we have indicated to you in our letter of October 27th, that included the revised draft proposed ballot measure, the City Council has determined that the retirement measure will be considered by the voters at a special election in early March 2012. Based on state and local election laws, the measure must be finalized and submitted approximately 90 days before the election. Meet and confer should be completed by the end of October if you wish to utilize any impasse procedures. Such procedures must be completed in early November.

Since we have no agreement on the draft proposed ballot measure and there are no further meetings scheduled for October, please let us know immediately if you wish to take advantage of the mediation provisions of the City's Employer-Employee Relations Resolution #39367 so that we can make the appropriate arrangements.
