## EMMA PRUSCH FARM – Reservable Picnic Areas

This 47-acre park features San Jose's largest barn. The El Jardin and Cornucopia gardens offer over 100 community garden plots. It has acres of open grass perfect for picnicking, kite flying, games, and relaxing. The barn and small animal area offers a close encounter with a wide range of farm animals such as sheep, pigs, steer, ducks, geese, rabbits, and much more! Alcohol, balloons and smoking are not allowed. One air jumper from a City-approved vendor is permitted only at Redwood Grove and Citrus Grove picnic sites upon approval of Parks Division office.
