



Fee Structural Changes Effective August 13, 2018

The City of San José implemented **structural fee changes** for the San Jose Fire Department Plan Check and Inspection Fees in accordance with *Development Services Cost Recover Analysis, Process Improvements, Calculation of Unearned Revenues and Refund Processing Report (Report)*.

Although the hourly rate has not changed effective Fiscal Year 2018-2019, to implement the fee restructuring and base hour changes as recommended in the *Report* requires modifications to the following fee structures:

- Fire Protection Systems – Clean Agent Fire Suppression System;
- Fire Protection Systems – Dedicated Function System, Sprinklers, Standpipes, & Pumps – Overhead Sprinkler System;
- NFPA 13D;
- Sprinklers, Standpipes, & Pumps – Overhead Sprinkler System PreAction System; and
- Sprinklers, Standpipes, & Pumps – Overhead Sprinkler System Tenant Improvement.
