

Chris Burton is Deputy Director, Office of Economic Development. Chris leads San Jose's Business Development Team, which is housed in Office of Economic Development, and is responsible for the City's relationship with its major corporate employers, largest revenue generators, and fastest growing emerging technology start-ups.
