B. Action Item – TPAC Recommendation for Approval Requested

The following items are scheduled to be approved by the San Jose City Council on March 18, 2008:

- 1. Approval of the Fifth Amendment to the construction service agreement with City of Santa Clara for the South Bay Water Recycling Program, revising the approved project list and extending the term of agreement by two years to June 30, 2010, at no additional cost to the City.
- 2. Report on bids and award of construction contract for the project RAS & SS Valve Replacement Project Secondary Tunnel Batter A (A-1 Thru A-6) to the low bidder, Anderson Pacific Engineering Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$729,000, and approval of a contingency in the amount of \$73,000.

 - b. Brown and Caldwell in an amount not to exceed \$5 million.

 - d. CH2M Hill in an amount not to exceed \$1 million.
 - e. Metcalf & Eddy in an amount not to exceed \$1 million.
