Capital Improvement Program



Program Snapshot: January - June

- \$181.6 million allocated in FY2014-2015
- 26 active projects
 - » 12 projects in feasibility
 - » 4 projects in design
 - » 6 projects in construction
 - » 2 projects in design-build
 - » 2 project in post-construction

- Biosolids Transition Strategy
- Project Delivery and Procurement Strategy
- Programmatic Studies
- Approval of 24 new CIP positions



Project Highlights (Construction)

- Digester Gas Compressor Upgrade
- Digester Gas Storage Replacement
- Emergency Diesel Generators
- Three projects reached beneficial use





Project Highlights (Design)

- Digester and Thickener Facilities Upgrade
- Iron Salt Feed Station
- Plant Instrument Air System Upgrade





Project Highlights (Feasibility)

- Procurement for four projects:
 - » Cogeneration Facility
 - » Facility-wide Water Systems Improvements
 - » Filter Rehabilitation
 - » Headworks



The Next Six Months

- Complete the Odor Control Study and obtain approval for Odor Control Implementation Plan
- Provide update on the Ten-Year Funding Strategy
- Pre-qualify contractors for Digester & Thickener Facilities Upgrade
- Select design-builder for Cogeneration Facility
- Continue with three consultant procurements

- Continue work on four programmatic studies
- Continue to develop five-year staffing & transition plan
- Continue recruitment efforts
- Reach beneficial use on four construction projects
- Continue design and/or designbuild work on six projects
