For blockages involving sewer mains in the street, please call the City of San José Department of Transportation at (408) 794-1900 (Monday-Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and (408) 277-8956 (after normal business hours).

** Property owners are responsible for the sewer line on their property and the portion of the sewer line that runs from their property to the connection with the main City sewer line.*
