#### A. Emergency Services Council Onboarding

## B. Emergency Operations Plan

# C. Disaster Service Worker Volunteer Program

The Director of Office of Emergency Management Raymond Riordan provided a presentation on the Disaster Service Worker Volunteer Program (DSWVP).

Action: Upon motion by Robert Sapien, second by Adam Amaral, the item was unanimously approved. The Emergency Services Council authorized the Office of Emergency Management to act as the City of San Jose DSWVP Adminstrator, authorized the registration of volunteers as DSW, and provided OEM the authority to adminster the Loyalty Oath to volunteers during preparedness and concurred with the ability to extend the authorization by the City Manager via memo, as needed. ## D. Community Emergency Response Team

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Memo.

Senior Executive Analyst Aurelia Bailey provided a presentation on the national CERT program, curricculum and the city's proposed training schedule for implementation.

<u>Action</u>: Upon motion by Mayor Sam Liccardo, second by Dana Reed, the item was unanimously approved. The Emergency Services Council approved the national CERT curriculum for local delivery with modifications to address the City of San Jose hazards and programs, and accepted the delivery schedule,

with knowledge that the Office of Emergency Management has the authority to adjust the schedule as needed with documentation. (14-0-4. Absent: Harkness, Fong, Fenton, King.)

## E. Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Services

Executive Analyst Daniel Tucker provided a presentation on the RACES program, Santa Clara County RACES training curriculum, and delivery schedule.

The Emergency Services Council approved the Santa Clara County RACES curriculum for local delivery and the proposed delivery schedule, with knowledge that the Office of Emergency Management has authority to modify the schedule as needed.
