January 6, 2020 to February 18, 2020	Write-In Candidacy Period ( <a href="#">Elec. Code § 8601</a> )  <i>Any qualified person wishing to file as a write-in candidate may pick up papers beginning this date. Papers must be filed with the City Clerk no later than 14 days prior to election day.</i>
