Come to our informational meeting to learn about the Reach Code Ordinance and Natural Gas Prohibition Ordinance for new buildings, which will apply to building permit applications made on or after January 1, 2020.

The Reach Code Ordinance encourages building electrification and energy efficiency; requires solar-readiness; and requires electric vehicle (EV)-readiness and EV equipment installation.

The Natural Gas Prohibition Ordinance prohibits installation of natural gas infrastructure for construction of new detached accessory dwelling units (ADUs), single-family homes, and low-rise multifamily buildings.
