The Council of the City of San José convened in Special Session at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

STRATEGIC SUPPORT SERVICES

3.1 Conduct a Public Hearing on the FY 2015-2016 Mayor's March Budget Message. (Mayor)

<u>Documents Filed</u>: Memorandum from Mayor Sam Liccardo, dated March 16, 2015, recommending that the Council direct the City Manager to submit a proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 that is balanced and guided by the policy direction and framework of priorities outlined in the Mayor's March Budget Message.

Mayor Sam Liccardo opened the Public Hearing.

<u>Public Comments</u>: Jerry Mungai expressed concern about the City's long term liabilities including debt repayment, post retirement pensions/unfunded liabilities and deferred infrastructure. Aurelia Sanchez voiced concern about homelessness. Clarence Madrilejos, Chair, San José Human Services Commission, expressed support to the Mayor's Human Trafficking Initiative to develop a policy and partnership to stop human trafficking.

The Mayor closed the Public Hearing

Mayor Sam Liccardo announced that the Public Hearing on the FY 2015-2016 Mayor's March Budget Message will be continued tomorrow afternoon at the March 24, 2015 Council Meeting. The Mayor pointed out that this is just the beginning of the Budget season and the public will have many more opportunities to provide input to the Council.
