Summary

The National Community Survey $^{\text{TM}}$ (The NCS $^{\text{TM}}$) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. The NCS captures residents' opinions within the three pillars of a community (Community Characteristics, Governance and Participation) across eight central facets of community (Safety, Mobility, Natural Environment, Built Environment, Economy, Recreation and Wellness, Education and Enrichment and Community Engagement). This report discusses trends over time, comparing the 2019 ratings for the City of San José to its previous survey results from 2011 through 2018. Additional reports and technical appendices are available under separate cover.

Trend data for San José represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines. Deviations from stable trends over time, especially, represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs or public information may have affected residents' opinions.

Meaningful differences between survey years have been noted within the following tables as being "higher" or "lower" if the differences are greater than six percentage points between the 2018 and 2019 surveys, otherwise the comparisons between 2018 and 2019 are noted as being "similar." Additionally, benchmark comparisons for all survey years are presented for reference. Changes in the benchmark comparison over time can be impacted by various trends, including varying survey cycles for the individual communities that comprise the benchmarks, regional and national economic or other events, as well as emerging survey methodologies.

Overall, ratings in San José for 2019 generally remained stable. Of the 129 items for which comparisons were available, 118 items were rated similarly in 2018 and 2019, 10 items showed an increase in ratings and one showed a decrease in rating. Notable trends over time included the following:

- While feelings of safety remained stable in 2019 compared to 2018, ratings various safety services increased (police, crime prevention and emergency preparedness) and more residents had stocked supplies for an emergency in 2019.
- Not only did more residents report using recreation centers in 2019 compared to 2018, but the quality rating for recreation programs improved.
- Economic outlook declined in 2019 compared to 2018 with fewer residents reporting that the economy would have a positive impact on their income.
