

# The Water and Wastewater Technology Program at Evergreen Valley College

The Water and Wastewater Technology (WWT) program at Evergreen Valley College offers courses designed to prepare students for employment by drinking water and wastewater agencies and private industrial treatment facilities. Careers in water/wastewater technology involve the administration, operation and maintenance of drinking water and wastewater treatment facilities, drinking water distribution systems, and wastewater collection systems. To supplement their regular classroom learning activities, students have opportunities to visit key water and

wastewater facilities, hear guest speakers from the industry, and participate in an internship.

Evergreen Valley College and the City of San José Environmental Services Department are partnering to host a Wastewater Treatment course for the 2020 Spring semester.
