Lan,

The San José Municipal Code does not currently require the printing of the campaign's physical address on campaign signs.

For your reference, I have also included a link to a chart from the FPPC's website where charts may be found outlining the various campaign disclosures required under State law:

Please also note, the San José Municipal Code requires certain disclaimers if the candidate desires to transfer city campaign funds to another campaign fund, under section [12.06.420](#), and for all communications in the spoken form distributed within 90 days of the election, under section [12.06.1010.C](#).
