In response to the reallocation appeals and per the request of the Commissioners, the Human Resources Department conducted a classification and compensation study for the Environmental Services Program Manager classification. The outcome of the study is to create a higher level classification, Senior Environmental Services Program Manager.

The current Environmental Services Program Manager classification remains; however, the Senior Environmental Services Program Manager classification has higher level duties and significant impact on City-wide organizational priorities.

In coordination with the Environmental Services Department, we will reallocate the three pending/denied reallocations to the newly created classification of Senior ESPM. All other positions will remain in the ESPM classification. We are targeting the March/April Civil Service Commission to file the new classification.
