RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

BACKGROUND

City-Council Initiated Neighborhood Improvement Reserve Fund/Other Budget Proposals

Program/Project Title: Crime Prevention Specialist Staffing

Amount of City Funding Required: \$673,494

Anticipated Outcomes: Requested funding changes would affect benefits or services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc., as described below: (Use as much space as required.)

The proposed budget recommends permanently eliminating the six filled Crime Prevention Specialist positions and redeploying two officers. This would cut the Challenges and Choices program, which provides alternative dispute resolution training to at-risk youth in elementary and middle schools. In addition to the loss of Challenges and Choices it would further burden the already, understaffed Police Community Services Division. This division has provided invaluable crime prevention services, such as Neighborhood Watch, Crime Stoppers, S.A.V.E., gang awareness training, and robbery prevention since its inception and represents a significant return on investment. After all, an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure.
