RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: Restore Use of the Alum Rock Youth Center

Amount of City funding required: \$323,523

Fund Type: General Fund

Anticipated Outcomes: Requested funding changes would effect benefits or services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc., as described below:

This proposal will restore the <u>Alum Rock Youth Center</u> from reuse with the city offering sub contracting to afterschool organizations (such as Boys and Girls Club) and morning educational services (such as Escuela Popular) to offset cost. In addition, have city staff permanently based there to offer drop in activities and league play in the Gym. By doing this, youth services are restored in a high-risk area providing the community with a much needed gang intervention outlet for young adults. This is an effective gang prevention and intervention measure and would benefit our entire City by reducing gang population and activities.
