## **RECOMMENDATION**

That the following recommendation be enacted.

## **Proposal**

Program/Project Title: School Safety - Expanded Crossing Guard Program

Amount of City Funding Required: \$48,000

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.): General Fund

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

The Adult Crossing Guard Program currently costs the City's General Fund \$1.36 million per year. This employs a little more than 33 FTEs (mostly part-time personnel). The program covers 104 authorized intersections at 87 schools. Of these schools, 5 are Santa Clara County schools. There are 7 crossing guards positioned at these schools. Santa Clara County has a cost sharing agreement with the City of San Jose. They pay the City of San Jose \$61,000 per year, which is the equivalent of 55% of the total cost of the crossing guards at these 5 schools.

The City of San Jose should request full payment for the cost of employing these crossing guards. The City would save over \$48,000 per year if fully reimbursed for the crossing guard services presently offered to the County at a discount. A portion of these savings can then be allocated to increasing school crossing safety at Guadalupe Elementary School and other high-priority locations.
