Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

This proposal would allow the City to increase program opportunities for our youth and seniors by redirecting the previously allocated \$2.1 million to Children's Health Initiative to essential services and programming for our residents, particularly our youth and seniors. With the 2.1 million dollars, \$250,000 of that would be an increase in San Jose BEST funding and the remainder of the funds (\$1,850,000) would be used to fund community-based non-profits that serve and provide services to youth and seniors within the City of San Jose.
