Program/Project Title: River Oaks Speed Radar Signs

Amount of City Funding Required: \$ 40,000 (one-time) & \$2,000 (ongoing)

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.): Essential Services Reserve & General Fund

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

Over the past few years, several new residential developments on River Oaks Parkway been constructed, a 5 acre park has opened, and nearby commercial businesses have expanded. Furthermore, River Oaks Parkway will become part of a school zone as soon as within 3 years. Vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle traffic have all increased over the past several years, and will only further increase in the near future. Yet, no additional traffic calming measures have been put into place. The installation of speed radar signs on River Oaks between North First Street & Montague Expressway would provide some relief to the tens of thousands of people who reside and work directly off of River Oaks Parkway. The specific locations of the signs will be determined based on a review of speed and crash data, and roadway geometry.
