RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: Mobile Radar Feedback Units

Amount of City Funding Required: \$ 17,700

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.): General Fund

This change is:

One-time Ongoing

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

A one-time purchase of two additional Radar Feedback Trailers to be used to inform drivers of their speeds as well to collect vehicle speed data. These trailers can be used to provide speed feedback to drivers on roads that can safely accommodate the unit without creating a hazard. Many residents of District 6 are concerned with the speeds at which vehicles are traveling on the roads and the purchase of two additional Radar Feedback Trailers would provide staff with more resources to deploy in areas that are requested. The data collected by the units would allow city staff the possibility of examining the speed data as well as placing the data in the collective "data lake" for future analysis. Additional Radar Trailers would also allow staff to respond to more requests from residents for speed feedback in their neighborhoods and surrounding roadways while also providing the short term speed reduction that the units provide.
