## RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

### Proposal

Program/Project Title: **Pomona Ave & Cottage Grove Stop Sign Enhancement**

Amount of City Funding Required: **\$20,000**

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.): **General Fund or Construction Excise Tax Fund**

This change is:

One-time       Ongoing

This three-way intersection frequently sees through traffic failing to stop at the posted stop signs. Pomona is also near a school and in the middle of a residential neighborhood, and located between two major arterial roads, Alma and Monterey Highway. This results in many vehicles frequently cutting through this neighborhood to avoid traffic during commute hours and often causes danger for residents or kids walking to school and throughout the neighborhood. Previous efforts to trim trees, post stop-sign warnings, roadway warnings, and other efforts have proven to have little to no impact. By creating a bulb out and placing the stop sign directly in a driver's line of site we hope to foster much greater compliance and neighborhood traffic safety.
