Program/Project Title: **CE# 23 – Installation of two electronic radar signs along Foxworthy Ave.**

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

Foxworthy Avenue is a heavily travelled east-west corridor (given it's relatively small size of two lanes) and is used by thousands of motorists each day. It was part of our 2016 Pavement Maintenance Program, and since the maintenance of Foxworthy Avenue, there have been several accidents due to the excessive speed of vehicles near the Kirk Community Center and at least one vehicle hit a house. With the installation of two electronic speed signs in the area, we feel they could have a traffic calming effect.
