## **RECOMMENDATION**

Program/Project Title: Great Oaks Viva Parks Summer Program

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

The Great Oaks Park and surrounding neighborhoods are experiencing an increase in gang activity and vandalism to the park. This area has been identified as a problem area by San Jose PD and is in need of positive programming to reduce the influx of recent crime. These funds could initiate a cohesive partnership between SJPD, The Mayor's Gang Prevention Task Force, PRNS and the community that would result in a placed-based approach that will engage youth and their families. The community would benefit from a safe place to play and a proven Viva Park program previously established in other Council districts by PRNS to increase positive activism and engagement for families.

Requested funds would affect youth and families located in nearby neighborhoods of Edenvale/Roundtable, Great Oaks, Eden Hill, and Coyote Creek to reclaim their park from negative activities currently taking place. It would have them engage in energetic activities that fosters good health and fun. Parks Recreation and Neighborhood Services is implementing this strategy with the Viva Parks Model.

I recommend expanding this model currently operating in East San Jose to the Great Oaks Park area. This approach will demonstrate to youth and families that it is safe to go to your neighborhood park to play basketball, ride their skateboards, or participate in an activity that is educational, enjoyable and safe.
