RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: Theft Intervention and Monitoring

Amount of City Funding Required: \$10,000

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

District 4 constituents report numerous concerns related to package thefts and burglaries in residential areas. \$10,000 would be allocated to develop the scope and cost estimates for the following proposal:

A proposal to fund a project to utilize the City's open source data from the SJPD to share real-time and historical crime trends on NextDoor. Currently, residents can only see who has filed a crime complaint on NextDoor, providing an impression of where crime is happening that is not based in fact, only the willingness to report. Staff would investigate utilizing data from Crime Reports and Crime Mapping as additional, but short-term, information sources. Employing our partnership with NextDoor, we would also provide residents with resources to create a neighborhood watch group, use data to identify fact-based crime trends, and provide resources for residents to improve safety and prevent crime in their neighborhoods.
