Program/Project Title: Traffic Calming/Street Safety Improvements for District 4

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

During my short tenure in office, I have heard numerous, serious concerns from residents about pedestrian safety. The concerns have identified increased frequency and speeds, especially near George Mayne Elementary School. This is a proposal to fund sites for the development and implementation of traffic calming measures in District 4. Among the sites identified by constituents include:

- o Kyle Street and at Salt Lake Drive [Penitencia Neighborhood]
- o N. 1st Street and Trinity Park, esp near George Mayne Elementary [Alviso]
- o River Oaks Parkway
- o Sierra Rd.
- o Hostetter and Sun Ln.
- o Grand Boulevard [Alviso - speeding]
- o State Street [Alviso – high speed traffic]

My Office has worked in concert with the Department of Transportation to best prioritize traffic calming projects for District 4, inclusive of the aforementioned sites.
