On December 4th, 2018, the City agreed to a land widen Branham Lane and improve Snell Avenue,		

DOT plans to use the right-of-way to widen Branham Lane and improve Snell Avenue. Currently, the roadway abruptly narrows down to one lane and forces cars to merge within a short distance. From 2008 to 2017, there have been 142 crashes, including three fatalities.

agreement gave Santa Clara County a 12-acre patch along the south side of Hellyer Avenue at Silicon

The additional land will allow for the road safety improvements, by adding sidewalks and protected walking and bicycling pathways. Other modification includes a new traffic signal at Kingspark Dr, a traffic signal modification at the Safeway driveway, new and upgraded streetlights, a new median island with landscaping, a new sidewalk on the south side,

Valley Boulevard in exchange for a 60' wide right-of-way comprising nearly nine acres along

stormwater bioretentions, and enhanced bike lanes, consistent with Complete Streets design standards.
